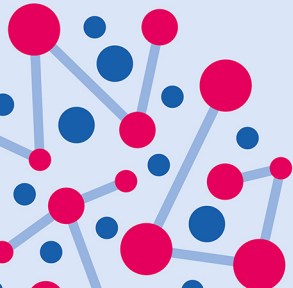




# Make a globe

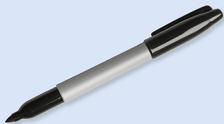

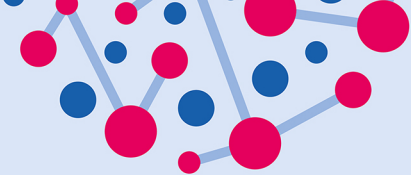
# You will need:

- Newspaper
- Mixing bowl
- Flour
- Warm water
- Punching ball balloon
- Black marker pen
- Paints (blue and green)
- Paintbrushes



1. Blow up the punching ball balloon and tie a knot in the end.
2. Cut up the newspaper into long strips and set aside.
3. Place two cups of flour into a mixing bowl and add two cups of water. Stir the mixture until it has no lumps.
4. Cover the entire balloon with strips of newspaper and the papier-mâché mix. Leave this to dry.





5. Use a black marker pen to draw on the continents on to the globe.
6. Paint the land, oceans and ice caps using green, blue and white paints.
7. Add labels to the globe to identify different continents and oceans, or other key places.
8. If you have enough time, you can also paint on large rivers, seas and lakes.
