




Make a globe

At-home science activity





twig EDUCATION

You will need:

- Newspaper
- Mixing bowl
- Flour
- Warm water
- Punching ball balloon
- Black marker pen
- Paints (blue and green)
- Paintbrushes







twig EDUCATION

- 1. Blow up the punching ball balloon and tie a knot in the end.
- 2. Cut up the newspaper into long strips and set aside.
- 3. Place two cups of flour into a mixing bowl and add two cups of water. Stir the mixture until it has no lumps.
- 4. Cover the entire balloon with strips of newspaper and the papier-mâché mix. Leave this to dry.







- 5. Use a black marker pen to draw on the continents on to the globe.
- 6. Paint the land, oceans and ice caps using green, blue and white paints.
- 7. Add labels to the globe to identify different continents and oceans, or other key places.
- 8. If you have enough time, you can also paint on large rivers, seas and lakes.
